As most of you are probably aware, I was asked and humbly accepted the role of Weekend Lay Director for the men's walk to be held October, 15 - 18, 2020.

I'll be completely transparent that I'd had high anxiety and struggled with this decision and only did so after much prayer, some pastoral discussions and the realization that I'm not in it alone. The EDWE board of Directors affirmed that I would be able to draw on them for help and I know that I have many, many close friends in our 4th Day. Since that time, I have been praying for discernment of God's will, not mine and a couple of times I have been reminded that **He has this!**

One of these times happened just this past week when I was on the receiving end of an extremely generous gift of Agape. I am not going to call anyone out as I am sure they would prefer to remain anonymous and I respect that. There was conflict between the men's walk dates and another significant mission event within our community. This would impact several people who are eligible to serve on both men's and women's teams as well as potential pilgrim candidates. Because of their high regard for both ministries and understanding that we would not be able to alter our dates, they moved the dates of their ministry event for Emmaus.

I just want to say that I was deeply moved by this act of kindness and I am touched more than I can express. This Agape Love was over the top and I am grateful. God Bless you!
